WHEREAS, the parties to this Interlocal Agreement wish to add Public Utility District No. 1 of Kittitas County and City of Ellensburg, Washington, as participants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Richland, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign and execute Amendment No. 2 to Interlocal Cooperative Agreement between the City of Richland, Public Utility District No. 1 of Benton County, Public Utility District No. 1 of Franklin County, Public Utility District No. 1 of Kittitas County, City of Ellensburg and Energy Northwest for installation of electric vehicle charging stations.
